# Class Descriptions



## **ESL 210** Conversation Practice for ESL Learners

You will improve your English and understanding of American culture while discussing topics of interest in a small group. You will become more confident using English and will also gain an appreciation of the different cultures represented by your classmates.

Prerequisite: ESL 244

## **ESL 211** Listening in Context

You will listen to a recording for class discussion and share your ideas about a variety of topics with your classmates. You will also work on your listening and conversation skills outside of class by conducting interviews on different topics.

## **ESL 213** Vocabulary and Idioms in Context

Every week, we will focus on a different topic, which will give you a chance to expand your vocabulary in different contexts through music, short readings, and conversation. You will become familiar with the idioms and expressions Americans use in daily conversation and able to recognize them more easily after taking ESL 213.

## **ESL 216** Advanced Book Reading Club

This class emphasizes the development of vocabulary and critical thinking skills through the discussion and analysis of an extended text working in a small group. The book we will be reading is announced on the LSL website.
