

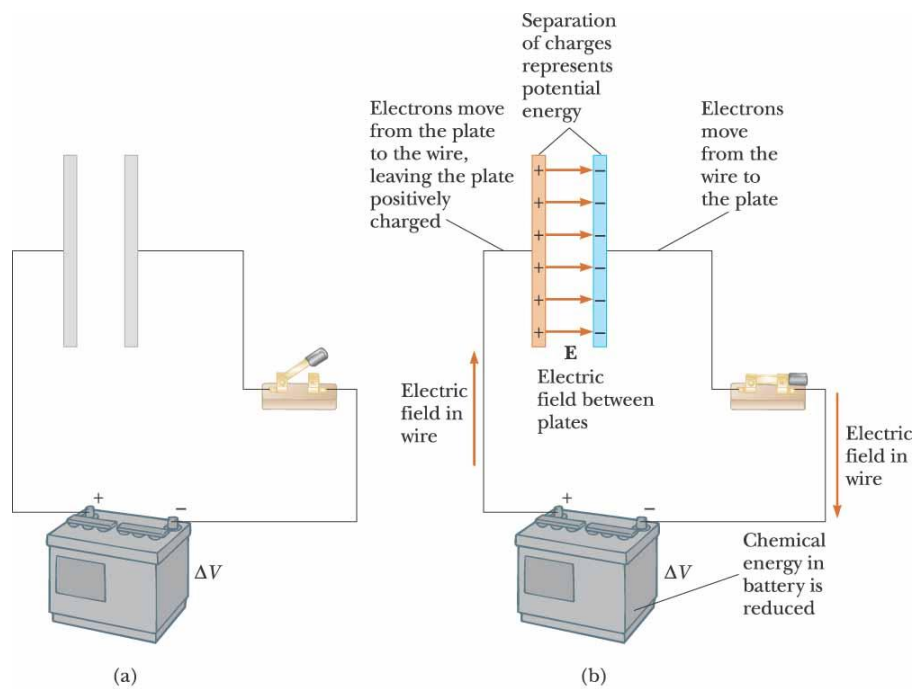
CAPACITORS
