SUBJECT: FHDA Financial Aid Survey, Winter 2013

The Financial Aid Survey was emailed to FHDA students who applied for Financial Aid for the 2012-13 year during Winter quarter 2013. A total of 1,876 people responded to the online survey (out of about 25,000).

Important highlights include:

- 95% of respondents knew that if they see red flags on the Financial Aid tab at MyPortal.fhda.edu, they "need to turn in that document," while 4% selected "You are not eligible for Financial Aid."
- 90% of respondents knew that they should apply for Financial Aid "every year," while 8% selected "Every quarter," and 2% selected "Just once when you first go to college."
- 82% of respondents knew that they find out what other Financial Aid documents they are required to turn in "At MyPortal.fhda.edu," while 17% selected "At FAFSA.gov," 1% selected "At CalGrant.edu," and 1% selected "At FinAid.org."
- 62% of respondents applied for Financial Aid for De Anza College, 23% applied for Financial Aid for Foothill College, and about 15% applied for Financial Aid for both colleges.
- 45% of respondents listed multiple colleges on their FAFSA.
- 25% of respondents selected that the 2012-13 is their first year at College.

Responses by *College* highlights include:

- 85% of De Anza College respondents reported they find out what other Financial Aid documents they are required to turn in *at MyPortal.fhda.edu*, while this percentage was 79% for Foothill College respondents.
- 80% of De Anza College respondents believe that the first step to apply for Financial Aid is to do the FAFSA, while this percentage was 75% for Foothill College respondents.
- 77% of De Anza College respondents knew *they have to check online at MyPortal.fhda.edu* in order to see if they are awarded Financial Aid, while this percentage was 71% for Foothill College respondents.

Responses by *Multiple College* highlights include:


- 80% of students who reported they know that the first step to apply for Financial Aid is to *do the FAFSA* applied for multiple colleges on FAFSA, while this percentage was 76% for those students who applied for single college on FAFSA.
- 58% of students who stated that they know if they are on probation or disqualified by *checking at MyPortal.fhda.edu* applied for single college on FAFSA, while this percentage was 48% for those students who applied for multiple colleges on FAFSA.
- 40% of students who reported that they know when they will get Financial Aid money by checking *MyPortal.fhda.edu* applied for single college on FAFSA, while this percentage was 35% for those students who applied for multiple colleges on FAFSA.

Important highlights of Spring 2011 and Winter 2013 comparison:

- In Spring 2011, 88% of respondents stated that the first step to apply for Financial Aid is to *do the FAFSA*, while in Winter 2013, this percentage was 85% for the same students.
- In Spring 2011, 88% of respondents reported that they should apply for Financial Aid *every year*, while in Winter 2013, this percentage was 92% for the same students.
- In Spring 2011, 84% of respondents to answer to *how will you get your Financial Aid money* selected "You sign up with Higher One Bank to get a bank account or have it sent it to your own bank account," while in Winter 2013, this percentage was 96% for the same students.
- In Spring 2011, 0% of respondents knew they can check if they are on probation or disqualified *at MyPortal.fhda.edu*, while in Winter 2013, this percentage was 100% for the same students.






* 3. Which ways can you apply for financial aid?


17. What is the highest education level of either parent?


18. Will 2012-13 be your first year at College?


19. Is this year the first time you completed the FAFSA?




