Subject: Listening and Speaking Center (LSC) survey, Spring 2013


A survey of Listening and Speaking Center (LSC) survey was conducted at the end of the Spring quarter in 2013. This resulted in 99 valid respondents.

Important Highlights Include:

- 100% of respondents who participated in ESL 251 Support Workshops "agree" or "strongly agree" that the workshops helped them improve their pronunciation, presentation, and/or listening skills (9e).
- 100% of respondents who participated in ESL 253 Support Workshops "agree" or "strongly agree" that the workshops helped them improve their grade in ESL 253 and English grammar (12b and 12e).
- 96% of respondents "agree" or "strongly agree" that their English skills have improved after using the LSC programs and resources (26a).
- 88% of respondents "agree" or "strongly agree" that they know more ways to improve their English skills after using the LSC programs and resources (26b).
- 87% of respondents "agree" or "strongly agree" that they have more confidence in using English after using the LSC programs and resources (26c).
- 84% of respondents who participated in ESL 251 Support Workshops "agree" or "strongly agree" that the workshops helped them improve their grade in ESL 251 (9b).
- 76% of respondents "agree" or "strongly agree" that their grades have improved after using the LSC programs and resources (26d).



Like: Made a new friend. Suggestion: Perhaps have it more structured











The only problem with the center is its size. It feels somewhat cramped and it can be hard to talk to people with so much background noise.






