Subject: SANKOFA Success Rates and Demographics - Winter 2010 to Fall 2012

## Methodology

Students enrolled in SANKOFA courses between winter 2010 and fall 2012 were tracked. This resulted in 272 unduplicated students. SANKOFA courses were identified as courses with section numbers ending in SK or SKS. Success rates were provided over the whole time period as well as by quarter. Success rates of SANKOFA students compared to non SANKOFA students in similar courses were also provided. Success rates of all SANKOFA students disaggregated by African Ancestry and all other ethnic groups were also compared as well as African Ancestry students in SANKOFA and non SANKOFA sections. Success was calculated on A, B, C, and P grades while non success was D, F, NP and I grades and withdraw was W grades. Demographics of SANKOFA students were provided which include: ethnicity, gender, age, residency status, GPA and major. Degrees awarded over the time period were also included.

## Overall Findings

- Over the time period, success rates in COUN80, EWRT001A, EWRT211, and LART211 were at or above $80 \%$. Success rates in EWRT002, READ211 and HUMA20 were between 75-80\%, while success rates in HUMA10 and HUMI006 were below 75\%.
- SANKOFA sections of EWRT001A, EWRT211, LART211, and READ211 had similar or higher success rates than non SANKOFA sections of the same course. SANKOFA sections of COUN80, EWRT002, HUMA20, HUMA10 and HUMI006 had lower success rates than the non SANKOFA section of the same course.
- SANKOFA students that identify as African Ancestry have higher or similar success rates than African Ancestry students in non SANKOFA sections of EWRT001A, EWRT002, EWRT211, HUMA10, LART211, and READ211.
- African Ancestry students have lower success rates than all other ethnics groups in SANKOFA courses with the exception of EWRT001A, where African Ancestry students have higher success rates than all other groups.
- $44 \%$ of students in the SANKOFA program identify as African Ancestry while $21 \%$ identify as Asian or Pacific Islander, 13\% identify as Latino and another 13\% as Unknown.
- $20 \%$ of SANKOFA students have not yet declared a major while $9 \%$ declared Business Administration, 8\% declared Liberal Arts in Social and Behavioral Science and 7\% declared Registered Nursing.
- $45 \%$ of SANKOFA students have a cumulative GPA between 2.1 and 3.0 while $24 \%$ have a GPA above 3.1.
- $73 \%$ of students are between the age of 20-24 while $12 \%$ are under 19 and $10 \%$ are between 25 and 29 years old.
- Of the students who were enrolled in a SANKOFA course over the time period, 28 unique students obtained an associate's degree.


## Success Rates

Table 1 displays the success rates of all students in SANKOFA courses over the time period. The overall success rate was $80 \%$. Success rates in COUN80, EWRT001A, EWRT211, and LART211 were at or above $80 \%$. Success rates in EWRT002, READ211 and HUMA20 were between 75$80 \%$, while success rates in HUMA10 and HUMI006 were below $75 \%$ over the time period.

Table 2 displays the success rates of students in SANKOFA courses over the time period compared to students in the same course but in a non SANKOFA section. SANKOFA sections of EWRT001A, EWRT211, LART211, and READ211 had similar or higher success rates than non SANKOFA sections of the same course. SANKOFA sections of COUN80, EWRT002, HUMA20, HUMA10 and HUMI006 had lower success rates than the non SANKOFA section of the same course for African Ancestry students.

Table 3 displays the success rates of African Ancestry students in SANKOFA courses compared to African Ancestry students in non SANKOFA sections of the same course. SANKOFA students that identify as African Ancestry have higher or similar success rates than African Ancestry students in non SANKOFA sections of EWRT001A, EWRT002, EWRT211, HUMA10, LART211, and READ211.

Table 4 displays the success rates of all students in SANKOFA courses but compares African Ancestry students to all other ethnic groups in the same SANKOFA courses. African Ancestry students have lower success rates than all other ethnics groups in SANKOFA courses with the exception of EWRT001A, where African Ancestry students have higher success rates than all other groups.
