SUBJECT: FHDA Scholarship Website Survey Results, Spring 2013

Students who logged on to the scholarship system in Spring 2013 were sent an online survey by email. A total of 281 students responded to the survey. The survey asked students about their experience using the on-line scholarship application.

Important highlights include:


- 69% of respondents completed the FAFSA for 2012-13 before applying for a Scholarship, and 31% didn't complete it.
- 69% of students applied for 1-3 scholarships, 15% applied for 4-6 scholarships, 7% applied for 7-9 scholarships, and 9% applied for 10 and more scholarships.
- 57% of respondents didn't have difficulty scanning documents that they needed to attach to their application, 23% had a little difficulty, and 20% had difficulty.
- 49% of students selected "This is great" when they saw an online system for scholarship advertising and scholarship applications at first, but 32% of students selected "This is great" after they finished applying for scholarships. Also, 12% of students selected "I'd rather it was on paper" before applying, and 11% selected "I'd rather it was on paper" after they finished applying for scholarships.
- 44% of respondents who had applied for FAFSA 2012-13 heard about the scholarships at Foothill / De Anza College from Financial Aid Website, but 31% of respondents who hadn't applied for FAFSA 2012-13 heard about the scholarships from Financial Aid Website.
- 40% of respondents indicated that they heard about scholarships at Foothill / De Anza College from Financial Aid Website, 18% heard from their Instructor, 17% heard from College Support Programs (EOPS, DSS, Puente, etc), 13% heard from their friends, 5% heard from Advertisement, 4% heard from Scholarship Listserv, and 4% heard from Classroom Presentation.
- 35% of respondents knew what scholarship(s) they wanted to apply for, and 65% didn't know.
- 31% of respondents applied for Foothill scholarships, 66% applied for De Anza scholarships, and 3% applied for scholarships of both colleges.

Important highlights of Comparison between Summer 2012 and Spring 2013 include:

- 69% of respondents to the Spring 2013 Scholarships Survey completed the FAFSA for 2012-13 before applying for a scholarship, while 74% of respondents to the Summer 2012 Scholarships Survey completed the FAFSA for 2011-12 before applying for a scholarship.
- 69% of respondents to the Spring 2013 Scholarships Survey applied for 1-3 scholarships, while 73% of respondents to the Summer 2012 Scholarships Survey applied for 1-3 scholarships.
- 40% of respondents to the Spring 2013 Scholarships Survey heard about scholarships at Foothill / De Anza College by Financial Aid website, while 50% of respondents to the Summer 2012 Scholarships Survey heard about scholarships at Foothill / De Anza College by Financial Aid website.






3. How many scholarships did you apply for?




5. Did you know what Scholarship(s) you wanted to apply for before visiting?


6. Did you attend a Scholarship Workshop before applying?


7. Did you complete the FAFSA for 2012-13 before applying for a Scholarship?


8. Did you have difficulty scanning documents that you needed to attach to your application (such as transcripts, letters of recommendation, and essays)?






11. On average, how much time did you spend preparing one scholarship application?



13. After you FINISHED applying for scholarships this year, what was your impression of the online system?



Easier system to apply for the scholarship. I couldn't figure out how the system works so I ended up not applying and I think its not fair.

A description that a printed scan of the transcript would be preffered. It took me a while to try to copy and paste it in a reasonable format.

There is no indication whatsoever of the minimum class units requirement for the quarter AFTER the submission of the scholarship. Is one expected to be a part-time student sthe next quarter? Even for a DSS student for whom this is a real hardship? I like the ability for the application process to save a draft version of the application, and just as important, that it unambiguous indicate as such emphatically and often. This is crucial for a system that is designed to allow only a one-time submission of the completed scholarship application! It would be hard enough, but for the anxiety inherent in doing so less determinately.

Some requirements were vague, for example the scholarship is for science majors and it requires Pass The Torch activity, but doesn't specify if it should be just in math.

Possibly highlighting or bolding, using a red color for the scholarships that will be due within a month, to catch applicant's eyes that the scholarship application will be due soon.

The application process was fair and easy to follow, no changes needed in my opinion

I think the online system is great. Easy to handle and convenient. All scholarships are listed in the same format which save people's time to scan every detail.

Let people reapply. Stupid if you withdraw an app. you cann't reapply... Just stupid...


Some flexiblity on grade point average would help. Some scholarships can not open because of grade point average. And the Grade point reflects everything taken for over 30 years.
