Subject: Community Engagement Survey, Spring 2013 – 'S' Designated Courses

The Community Engagement survey was conducted in the spring quarter. It was sent to all enrolled students with a valid email address (17,279) at the end of the quarter (May 15) in order to capture activities students participated in throughout the academic year. Students could access the survey through their email or MyPortal account. The survey was then separated into respondents who have taken a Community or Civic Engagement course between 2012 and 2013. These students are identified as 'S' Students. This resulted in 162 valid responses.

The results show:

Since entering De Anza College, have you participated in the following activities?

- 81% of 'S' students discussed politics compared to 62% of all other students.
- 76% of 'S' students volunteered compared to 42% of all other students.
- 38% of 'S' students voted in a student election at De Anza compared to 26% of all other students.
- 30% of 'S' students worked on a local, state or national campaign, a much higher percentage compared to 13% of all other students.

Since entering De Anza College I have increased my knowledge of:

- 43% of 'S' students stated they strongly agree or agree that their knowledge has increased in regards to national issues compared to 26% of all other students.
- 42% of 'S' students stated they strongly agree or agree that their knowledge has increased in regards to global issues compared to 25% of all other students.

Since entering De Anza College I have increased my ability to:

- 93% of 'S' students strongly agree or agree that their ability to see things from the perspective of others increased compared with 88% of all other students.
- 81% of 'S' students strongly agree or agree that they see themselves as part of the campus community at De Anza versus 72% of all other students.
- 75% of 'S' students strongly agree or agree that their ability to have an impact on social change or political change increased compared with 53% of all other students.

Since entering De Anza College, I believe more now than I did before that:

- 92% of 'S' students stated they strongly agree or agree that they believe more now than before that helping others is personally rewarding compared to 85% of all other students.
- 90% of 'S' students stated they strongly agree or agree that they believe more now than before that they have something to offer the world compared to 82% all other students.
- 81% of 'S' students stated they strongly agree or agree that they believe more now than before that that they are able to affect social or political change compared to 64% of all other students.

Political Knowledge

- 71% of 'S' students versus 60% of all other students identified that a 2/3 vote is required for the U.S. Senate and House of Representatives to override a presidential veto.
- 29% of 'S' students versus 32% of all other students identified that if the President of the United States fails to sign or veto a bill sent to him within 10 days, it automatically becomes a law.
- 62% of both Political Science students and all other students identified that the Supreme Court has the responsibility to make the final decision on whether a law is constitutional or not.
