A survey of LinC program students was conducted at the end of the Fall quarter in 2013. The survey was distributed to all students enrolled in a LinC course which resulted in 176 valid respondents. All sections of the LinC program were given the opportunity to participate in the survey.


Important Highlights Include:

- 99% of respondents reported they would recommend this learning community to a friend or family member.
- 89% of respondents stated they worked with classmates during class "very often" or "often."
- 86% of respondents described the quality of their relationship with teachers in this learning community is "very friendly, supportive and helpful" or "friendly, supportive and helpful."
- 86% of respondents described the quality of their relationship with classmates in this learning community as "very friendly, supportive and helpful" or "friendly, supportive and helpful."
- 77% of respondents described their overall educational experience in this learning community as "Excellent" or "very good."

•	31% of respondents reported that they found out about the learning community through a counselor, 30% were told by a friend, 19% saw it on the online schedule of classes, 12% were told by a teacher, 4% heard from a speaker in class and 3% saw it on a flyer. The last 1% of respondents reported that the course title or topic interested them.






In this learning community, how often have you done items #3-17?




































