Subject: De Anza College Veterans - 2011-12 to 2012-13
Veterans enrolled at De Anza College between summer 2011 and spring 2013 were tracked. Students identified in the Banner Cohort table as: Vets Recvg Benefits, Vets Fee Waiver, Vets Priority Reg, Vets Tuition Asst, Vets Guest, VRAP, and Vets were included.

The analysis includes: enrollment by quarter; success rates by academic year; enrollment by ethnicity and gender; average GPA; course credits attempted and passed; educational goal; educational level; degrees awarded; persistence rate; transfers to 4 -year institutions.

- Between summer 2011 and spring 2013, De Anza College served 2,628 students in one of the veteran categories.
- The largest category is Veterans Receiving Benefits, this included 1,859 students over the time period.
- The second largest group is Veterans with a Fee Waiver, this accounted for 372 students over the time period.

- The average success rate of all veterans in 2011-12 was $72 \%$.
- Students who were coded as Veteran Tuition Assistance exhibited the highest success rates in all of their courses in 2012-13, with a success rate of $78 \%$, followed by Veterans Receiving Benefits at 77\% success.
- All other groups exhibited success rates above $70 \%$ with the exception of Veterans who exhibited a success rate of $61 \%$.

- The average success rate of all veterans in 2012-13 was 78\%.
- Students who were coded as Veteran Guest and Tuition Assistance exhibited the highest success rates in all of their courses in 2011-12, with a success rate of $93 \%$.
- All other categories exhibited success rates below $72 \%$ with the exception of Veterans who exhibited a success rate of $58 \%$.

Of all veterans identified over the time period, $32 \%$ identify as White followed by $23 \%$ as Latino, $16 \%$ as Filipino, and $15 \%$ as Asian/Pacific Islander.

- For Veteran Guests, $46 \%$ identify as White while $29 \%$ identify as Latino.
- For Veterans Receiving Benefits, $33 \%$ identify as White, $25 \%$ as Latino, and $16 \%$ as Asian/Pacific Islander.

- Of all veterans identified over the time period, $74 \%$ identify as male while $26 \%$ identify as female.
- The largest populations that identify as female are those identified as Veterans at $56 \%$ followed by $51 \%$ of Veterans with a Fee Waiver identifying as female.

- Of all veterans identified over the time period, they exhibited an average GPA of 2.63.
- Students receiving Veterans Tuition Assistance exhibited the highest GPA over the time period of 3.02.
- All groups exhibited a GPA over 2.4 with the exception of VRAP students.

- Of all veterans identified over the time period, they passed $78 \%$ of the courses in which they enrolled.
- The population that passed the highest number of courses in which they were enrolled were Veteran Tuition Assistance at $85 \%$ of courses passed followed by Veteran Guest at $84 \%$ of courses passed.
- The population that passed the lowest number of courses in which they were enrolled were Veterans and VRAP at $66 \%$ and $38 \%$ of courses passed.

- Of all veterans identified over the time period, $64 \%$ identified their educational goal as Obtain A.A. and transfer to a 4 year institution or Transfer to a 4 -year institution without an A.A.
- $79 \%$ of students identified as Veterans Fee Waiver stated their goal to be Obtain A.A. and transfer to a 4-year institution or Transfer to a 4 -year institution without an A.A. followed by $69 \%$ of students identified as Veterans Guest Followed and $63 \%$ of Veterans Tuition Assistance with the same educational goals.

- The majority of all veterans' prior education level is a high school diploma at $74 \%$ of the population.
- $12 \%$ of Veterans Tuition Assistance have a Bachelor's degree, followed by $8 \%$ of students identified as Veterans Priority Registration, $8 \%$ of Veterans Receiving Benefits, $8 \%$ with a Fee Waiver, and $8 \%$ of Guests.

- Of all veterans enrolled in fall 2011, 246 returned the following quarter for a persistence rate of $72 \%$.
- Of all veterans enrolled in winter 2012, 80\% persisted to spring 2012.
- Of all veterans enrolled in spring 2012, $48 \%$ enrolled in the summer quarter.

- Of all veterans enrolled in fall $2012,76 \%$ enrolled in the following winter.
- Of all veterans enrolled in winter 2013, $78 \%$ enrolled in the following spring.
