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Subject: Learning in Communities (LinC) Success Rates, 2014 to 2016

LinC (Learning in Communities) is an innovative approach to learning designed for student success that links two or more classes together with a common theme, content, and materials. These courses are open to all De Anza students and are designed to offer a better way to learn.

This report analyzes the success rates of LinC students who were enrolled in LART, EWRT, and READ 200 or 211 courses between 2013-14 and 2015-16 academic years. The success rates of LinC students are compared with non-LinC students in the same courses, but in a non-LinC section. In addition, the success rates of LinC targeted student populations¹ was compared with non-LinC targeted student populations. Retention rates for LinC courses were calculated and compared with non-LinC courses.

Success includes A, B, C, and P grades, Non-success includes D, F, and I grades and Withdraw are W grades. The retention rate calculates the percentage of students who do not withdraw from class and who receive a valid grade (A, B, C, P, D, F, NP, I / A, B, C, P, D, F, I, NP, P, W).

Highlights Include

- A higher rate of African American students were enrolled in LinC (8%) than non-LinC (5%) courses, and fewer White students were enrolled in LinC (6%) than non-LinC (13%) courses.
- Male students had a slightly larger majority in LinC (51%) and non-LinC (53%) courses than female students.
- LinC courses had a higher retention rate than non-LinC courses by 8%. This retention rate difference was the same between targeted and non-targeted LinC students.
- A combined analysis of all three academic years showed that LinC students had a higher success rate than non-LinC students across all courses except EWRT 200 (LinC 75%, non-LinC 77%) and READ 200 (LinC 72%, non-LinC 75%).
- Among the targeted population, success rates were also higher in all LinC than non-LinC courses with the exception of READ 200 (LinC 73%, non-LinC 76%).

¹ Targeted student populations include African American, Latino/a, and Filipino students.


Demographic Information

Ethnicity:

The rates of enrollment between LinC and non-LinC courses was similar across all ethnic groups. A few differences between the two groups can be observed among African American students and White students:

- More students who identify as African American were enrolled in LinC courses (8%) than non-LinC courses (5%).
- Less students who identify as White were enrolled in LinC courses (6%) than non-LinC courses (13%).






Retention Rates

Retention Rates by Year:

Students who were enrolled in LinC courses were less likely to withdraw from their classes than non-LinC students. This can be observed consistently for each academic year that was analyzed. The highest retention rate for LinC courses was in 2015-16 (96%) while the lowest retention rate was in 2013-14 (91%).

Non-Targeted vs. Targeted Population Retention Rates:

The retention rates of targeted populations were lower than non-targeted populations by 2 percentage points among LinC and non-LinC courses. However, retention rates among targeted and non-targeted groups were 7 percentage points higher in LinC courses than non-LinC courses.
