Subject: International Student (F1) Enrollment

### Overview

Students who had an F1 visa type were identified during the following three terms: Spring 2010, Spring 2011 and Spring 2012. Table 1 shows the enrollment by college over the three spring terms. The data suggest that F1 student enrollment within the FHDA district has increased over the past three years (by 10% from Spring 2010-11 and 9% from Spring 2011-12). At the college level, F1 student enrollment increased 6% at De Anza and 13% at Foothill between Spring 2011 and Spring 2012.

East Asia has the most F1 students represented within the FHDA district, and their numbers have increased each year. This is also the case for South East Asia (Table 2).

Figure 1 shows the representation by region among F1 students who were enrolled at De Anza and Foothill Colleges during Spring 2012. The East Asia region composes the majority or 61% (1,762 students) of the 2,904 F1 students. South East Asia (22%) and Europe/Eurasia (8%) represent the second and third largest regions.






When examining F1 enrollment as a three-year trend by country of origin, China has the largest student enrollment within the FHDA district and their representation has continued to increase (from 407 in Spring 2010 to 677 in Spring 2012). With the exception of Sweden, all the top countries represented are from East Asia and Southeast Asia. Unlike the other nations represented, enrollment from Japan and India declined during the same time period (Table 3).

The F1 student enrollment patterns by country of origin at De Anza and Foothill Colleges show some differences. At De Anza, more students enroll from China, East Asia and Southeast Asian nations while at Foothill, students from Europe/Eurasia and North America help compose the top ten countries represented (Figures 2 and 3).










Table 4 shows the enrollment based on the F1 students' country of origin; 109 nations are represented between De Anza and Foothill Colleges.

## Methodology

Enrollment counts were determined as of the census date for each term. The spring terms have historically yielded higher F1 enrollment compared to the other quarters. Students were identified based on visa type, focusing on those with F1 status. The countries of origin were determined based on the nation that issued the visa. The world regions were complied based on the categories provided by the De Anza International Student Programs Supervisor (see below).
