Subject: Summer Bridge - FYE

In summer 2016, participants of De Anza College's Summer Bridge program were provided the opportunity to participate in the Summer Bridge Survey from Student Success and Retention Services (SSRS). Participants were asked which other SSRS programs they had interest in. This resulted in 19 responses to SSRS's First Year Experience Program survey.

Important highlights include:

- While 74% of participants agreed their high school had the resources necessary to prepare them for a college education, only 42% of participants agreed that they were satisfied with the college guidance and counseling they received in high school (Question 3a, 3c).
- 26% of participants listed "a family member encouraged them" as their primary reason to attend De Anza (Question 7).
- 68% of participants strongly agree their mother is supportive of their decision to attend De Anza College, and 52% strongly agree their father is supportive of their decision. 5% of participants strongly disagree that their father is supportive if their decision (Question 9, 10).
- 79% of participants are often distracted by their family members when studying at home (Question 12).
- 47% of participants live more than 10 miles away from De Anza College (Question 15).
- 47% of participants plan to take public transportation to De Anza for Summer Bridge (Question 16).
- 63% of participants plan to take public transportation to De Anza for the fall term (Question 17).





11. Do you have any siblings who have graduated from a four-year institution with a bachelor's degree? Mean: 2.00


