
## De Anza College – Survey of Basic Needs – Fall 2018



Only 5% of students who experience homelessness receive housing assistance



**40%** of students with food insecurity worry about running out of food and not having money to buy more


Only 10% of students with food

insecurity are utilizing SNAP benefits

Approximately 685 students were BOTH food and housing insecure

**21%** of students with housing insecurity indicated they moved in with people due •---to financial problems

The 2018 #REALCOLLEGE Survey school report for De Anza college was prepared by the Hope Center for College, Community, and Justice at Temple University. The survey questionnaire was sent by email to approximately 20,700 students from De Anza College and 2,211 students participated. Thus, the estimated response rate is 11%.
