Subject: Transportation Survey, Winter 2017

The transportation survey was distributed to 2,000 randomly selected De Anza students during the winter quarter of 2017, which was 10% of the total student body. The survey intended to determine if there is a need for a direct bus route between De Anza and Foothill College. 269 students responded to the survey, resulting in a response rate of 13%. Demographic information including age, gender, and ethnicity were collected and reported. Transportation based questions focused around methods of transportation, Eco Pass usage, and a proposed Santa Clara Valley Transportation Authority (VTA) bus line between De Anza and Foothill College.

Important highlights include:

- The highest rate of participation was 32% (87) among respondents between 19 to 24 years old. The second highest participation rate was 24% (64) from students over 50 years old. Rates of participation among other age groups were 19% (50) from respondents between 22 to 29 years, 9% (25) from respondents between 30 to 34 years, 6% (16) from respondents between 35 to 39 years, and 9% (24) from respondents between 40 to 49 years. None of the survey respondents were 18 years old or younger (Question 1).
- 63% (169) of respondents were part-time students taking fewer than 12 units, and 36% (98) of respondents were full-time students taking 12 or more units (Question 3).
- 50% (134) of all respondents reported living in the city of San Jose. The rest of participating students reported living in other nearby cities at rates of 10% or less (over 20 other cities were cited) (Question 4).
- 72% (194) of respondents reported using a personal vehicle as their main method of transportation to De Anza, while 20% (54) reported taking the bus. Other methods of transportation were reported at rates that were less than 5% (other methods of transportation included biking, walking, and getting a ride with a friend/family member) (Question 7).
- 46% (123) of respondents indicated they have acquired an Eco Pass through De Anza, while 52% (140) indicated they have not (Question 8).
- 82% (220) of respondents have never taken a class at Foothill while also attending De Anza. 17% (45) of respondents reported attending both campuses in the same quarter (Question 10).
- 43% (115) of respondents have had transportation concerns while considering taking classes at both De Anza and Foothill Colleges, while 55% (147) have not considered these concerns (Question 12).

- 63% (169) of respondents would consider using a direct VTA bus line between De Anza and Foothill Colleges. 61% (163) of respondents indicated that this bus line would make it easier to take classes at Foothill College (Questions 13 and 14)
- 46% (124) of respondents indicated they would be interested in participating in intercampus activities between De Anza and Foothill if a direct bus line existed between the two campuses, while 51% (137) indicated that they would not be interested (Question 15).


