The Intersegmental General Education Transfer Curriculum (IGETC) is a series of courses that California community college (CCC) students may complete to satisfy the lower-division breadth/general education requirements before transferring to the California State University (CSU) or to the University of California (UC). CCC can certify completion of IGETC, which is accepted by all the CSU campuses and many majors at all UC campuses. **A course can only be certified if it was approved for IGETC when it was taken. Courses on this list are approved for academic year 2024-2025.** For a complete listing of courses, their approval dates, and any transfer credit limitations, visit ASSIST.org. All courses must be completed with grades of "C" or better OR with a "Pass" if the course was taken on a Pass/No Pass (P/NP) basis and the Pass is equal to a C grade or higher. Many colleges and universities require letter grades for major coursework, and/or have other restrictions on P/NP grades. Students are advised to consult with a counselor/academic adviser before selecting the P/NP option. See a counselor/academic adviser about UC majors, colleges, and professional schools which do not accept IGETC, and for other transfer requirements. Upon enrolling in final course requirements and receiving conditional admission to the university, students must submit a request for certification to the De Anza College Admissions and Records Office. Those with catalog rights prior to fall 2023 are not required to complete **Area 7**, but 12-15 quarter units in **Area 4** (from at least 2 disciplines) are required if **Area 7** is not complete.

CSU Graduation Requirement: U.S. History, Constitution, and American Ideals - Not part of IGETC, but may be completed prior to transfer. 9 quarter units. Complete **US-1**, **US-2**, and **US-3**.

- For **US-1**, select one course: **AFAM 12A, 12B; HIST 17A, 17AH or 17B, 17BH, 17C, 17CH, 18A, 18B**
- For **US-2/US-3**: Select one course: **POLI 1/1H**

Courses taken to satisfy this requirement may also be used to satisfy IGETC **Area 3** and/or **Area 4** at the discretion of the receiving campus; check with the Admissions Office at the receiving CSU campus to confirm double-counting allowance.

UC Graduation Requirement: American History & Institutions (AH&I) - Each campus decides how students may meet the requirement. Most transfer students fulfill this requirement through satisfactory completion of a one-year course in U.S. history or a half-year course in U.S. history and a half-year course in American government in high school. **Check UC campus catalogs for more information.**

IGETC for STEM - Students earning an Associate Degree for Transfer in a high-unit STEM major may be eligible to complete IGETC for STEM, deferring two to three lower-division GE courses until after transfer. At De Anza College, the Biology AS-T allows the use of IGETC for STEM. IGETC for STEM certification as part of the Biology AS-T requires completion of:

- All courses in **Area 1** (except Subarea 1C for UC bound students), **Area 2**, **Area 5**, and **Area 7**.
- One course in **Area 3A**; one course in **Area 3B**; and one course in **Area 4**.

Note: These deferred lower-division courses must be replaced with calculus and/or science courses required by the major before transfer.

(UC will only accept IGETC for STEM if the UC major program/college accepts partial IGETC certification.)
