

# Project Groups and Roles

Each group should have 6-8 students and each student will be responsible for a specific role in the group. As we all know, group work can be challenging because each student brings a different set of skills and availabilities. Please choose a role that fits your unique strengths when it comes to working in teams.

## Project Manager (only one per group):

- Acts as liaison between professor, peer mentors, and group members and keeps everyone on task

## Researcher:

- Conducts background research on the location
- Good for those who prefer to do their work alone and get nerdy about history.

## Interviewer:

- Organizes and conducts the interview about the place

## Writer:

- Creates interview questions, crafts the narrative of the oral history
- Good for those who like asking questions, putting thoughts into writing, and finding the deeper meaning in a story.

## Editor:

- Puts together the final project
- Good for those who like to make sure all the pieces of a project fit together and like to put those finishing touches on the whole project.
