De Anza's Institutional Research use of the "Asian American" and "Pacific Islander" student categories include the following groups: *Asian Indian, Asian/Other Asian, Cambodian, Chinese, Fijian, Filipino, Guamanian, Hawaiian, Japanese, Korean, Laotian, Other Pacific Islander, Samoan, Tongan, and Vietnamese* (ASAM webpage); however, no quantitative data is currently available for these individual groups.

The problem with aggregate data for Asian Americans and Pacific Islanders is that as a monolithic grouping, Asian Americans are perceived as largely successful - the "model minority" - yet key educational problems for marginalized subgroups (largely Southeast Asian populations) are concealed, thus furthering the equity gap.
