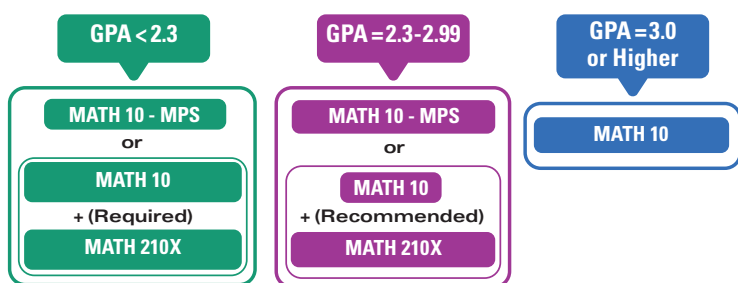

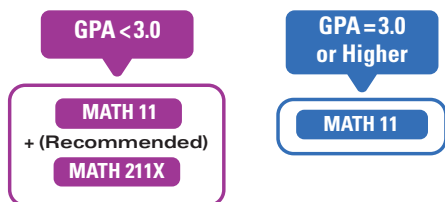

Humanities and Liberal Arts Majors: Four options, depending on academic goals and U.S. high school GPA

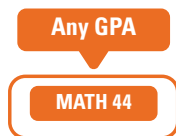

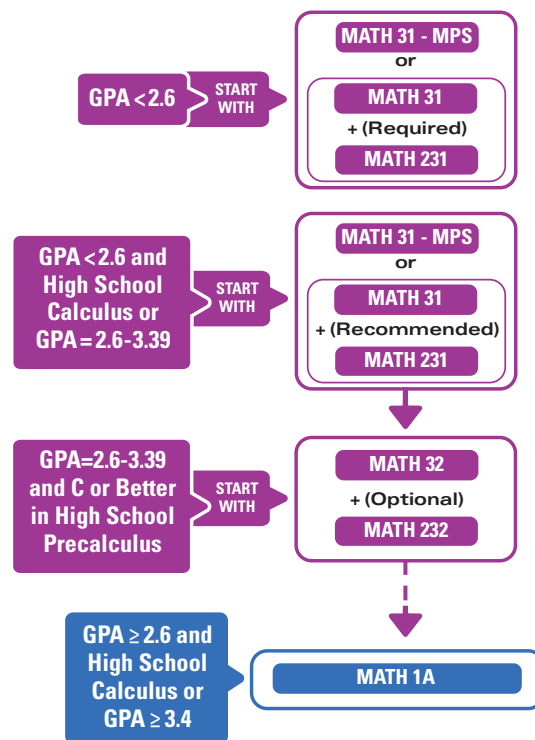

Notes

- A transfer level math course placement (MATH 10, 11, 44, 46 or MATH 31 and higher) allows you to register for any course that has a prerequisite of intermediate algebra, or other developmental math.
- A MATH 32 course placement (or higher) makes you eligible for **MATH 12** and other courses that have a prerequisite of MATH 31.
- De Anza's Math Department launched the two course Precalculus series (MATH 31 > MATH 32) in 2020. See your counselor if you took MATH 41, 42, or 43 in the past.

If you didn't complete grades 9 through 11 in a U.S. high school, or if you don't know your GPA because you've been out of high school for several years
