<u>15.1 Methods for Holding ICC Meetings for November 2022</u> (Info/Discussion/Action) Presenter: Cedric Buenviaje (ICC Chair of Club Affairs) & Maritza Arreola (ICC Advisor) This item is to decide on the method for holding ICC Agenda and Representative Meetings for November 2022 in accordance with Assembly Bill 361. Possible Motions:

- a) Move to have ICC Agenda and Representative Meetings meet online only in accordance with Assembly Bill 361 for the month of November 2022 due to continued state of emergency.
- b) Move to have the ICC Agenda and Representative Meetings simultaneously on campus and online (HyFlex) in accordance with Assembly Bill 361 for the month of November 2022 due to the continued state of emergency.
- c) Move to have ICC Agenda and Representative Meetings on campus only for the month of November 2022.
- De Anza Creative Writers (DACW) moved to have the ICC Agenda and Representative Meetings simultaneously on campus and online (HyFlex) in accordance with Assembly Bill 361 for the month of November 2022 due to the continued state of emergency. Seconded by LGBTQ+Alliance. Objected by Black Student Union (BSU) put to a vote
 - A total of 32 clubs voted. The majority vote was thus set to 17. (50%+1)
 - o 18 Clubs Voted NO, 11 Clubs voted YES, and 3 Clubs voted to ABSTAIN.

• Motion does not pass.

 International Student Connection (ISC) moved to have ICC Agenda and Representative Meetings meet online only in accordance with Assembly Bill 361 for the month of November 2022 due to continued state of emergency. Seconded by Black Student Union (BSU). No objections. • Motion passed: the Method for Holding ICC Meetings for November 2022 is set to be online only in accordance with Assembly Bill 361 for the month of November 2022 due to continued state of emergency.

15.2 Resuming Inactive Fund Process

(Info/Discussion)

Presenter: Maritza (ICC Advisor) & Will Wu (ICC Chair of Finance) This item is to discuss on updating pause on the Inactive Hold process set in place due to COVID-19, and answer questions on this process. Original Proposed Motion:

- a) Move to resume Inactive Hold process at the end of Fall quarter 2022. Inactive Clubs will have until the end of the quarter to reactivate any inactive clubs. Club funds already in the Inactive Hold Account would be moved, 75% to the ICC Scholarship account and 25% to the ICC Fund 44 Account. Active club accounts for clubs considered Inactive by the end of Fall quarter would be moved to the ICC Inactive Hold account for up to one year.
 - ICC Advisor and ICC Chair of Finance presented overview of ICC Codes regarding Inactive Club funds and clarified timeline of proposed motion. Attachment includes presentation shared
 - Revised possible motions (can be further amended by ICC or clubs):
 - "Move to resume Inactive Hold process at the end of Fall quarter 2022. Inactive Clubs will have until the end of the quarter to reactivate. Club funds already in the Inactive Hold Account would be permanently moved, 75% to the ICC Scholarship account and 25% to the ICC Fund 44 Account. Existing club accounts for clubs considered Inactive by the end of Fall quarter would be moved to the ICC Inactive Hold account, where they would be available for reactivation for up to one calendar year."
 - "Move to partially resume Inactive Hold process at the end of Fall quarter 2022. Inactive Clubs that were named Inactive between July 2019 and February 2020, which are in the Inactive Hold Account, will have until the end of the quarter to reactivate. Club funds still in the Inactive Hold Account by November 30th would be permanently moved, 75% to the ICC Scholarship account and 25% to the ICC Fund 44 Account. The pause will remain on accounts for recently Inactive Clubs to be reassessed at (*Winter quarter 2023/end of current academic year/other date*)."
 - De Anza Creative Writers: Suggested setting deadline to sometime during winter quarter is better because fall quarter is half over. Art Guild seconded this comment. No other comments. No action to be taken at this time, ICC will revise for future date.
