Your Week 11 with MESA!

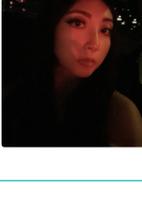
Welcome to Week 11!

Meet our MESA Tutor Yadira Lopez!

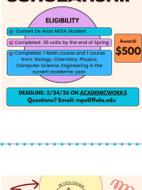

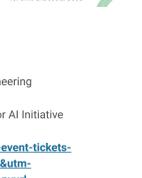
ScholarMatch Virtual informational Sessions every Tuesday
